EAST OF ENGLAND

Thornycroft Trusty eight-wheelers were introduced in 1946, with the NR/MV model, powered by a 100bhp diesel engine. For 1957 the PK/QR6 Trusty had a more powerful 9.83litre 130bhp engine. Single headlights were later upgraded to twin. This model dates from 1960.

FIELDS OF GOLD
